Effective Spring Quarter, 2008, student advising at the Concord Campus will follow the same model as advising on the Hayward Hills Campus. Staff advisors at the Concord Campus will provide students with all of their non-major advising. Major advising will be provided by faculty from the academic departments. These services and schedules are outlined below.

Our Services

- Guidance on fulfilling your General Education (GE) and graduation requirements (other than major requirements).
- Assistance in developing realistic educational goals and a plan to achieve those goals.
- Help in understanding and clarifying academic policies and procedures.
- Completion of your GE graduation check once you have achieved graduating senior status.
- Assistance with the entire process of researching, selecting, or changing your major(s) if you are an undeclared/undecided student.
- Referral to the many resources and services available throughout our campus community.
- Special academic counseling services to get you back on track if you are experiencing academic difficulties or are placed on academic probation.

Our Schedule

First four days of each quarter (excluding Friday):

10:00 am - 12:00 pm and 2:30 - 6:30pm (**drop in advising only**)

Normal hours of operation:

Monday - Thursday 10:00 am - 6:30 pm (appointments only; last appointment is at 6:00 pm)
