The Criminal Justice Administration major is designed to develop knowledge and understanding of practices, theory, and concepts of justice administration, as well as prepare students for professional careers in justice administration, law enforcement, corrections, and graduate studies. The Law Enforcement & Administration Option is offered at the Concord Campus. The program at the Concord Campus prepares students for work in government agencies and private organizations, offering challenging positions in crime prevention, investigation, and control.

Scheduling

The Criminal Justice Administration major is primarily an evening program. The course schedule allows students to complete upper division requirements within two years.

Admission

Cal State East Bay operates on a quarter system. Applications for admission are accepted every quarter. The Concord Campus offers only upper division courses for this major. To attend classes on the Concord Campus, it would be best for students to have completed all lower division requirements.
